## READY, SET, GO! "GET FIT SAN DIEGO" STARTS IN JANUARY

Chamber and Kaiser Permanente partner on workforce health and wellness

**SAN DIEGO** (Dec. 12, 2019) – For those looking for a little motivation to accomplish their health and wellness resolutions in the new year, the San Diego Regional Chamber is here to help with its annual Get Fit San Diego Challenge. Get Fit is a fun and friendly fitness competition that gives participants a helping hand on their health related-goals, while underscoring the importance of a healthy, happy workforce. Sponsored by Kaiser Permanente, registration is now open for the 30-day challenge, which begins January 13, 2020.
