Nominees may be anyone from a high level executive in a profitmaking company, to a visionary entrepreneur who is blazing new trails, to a leader of a nonprofit organization or public agency who is truly making a difference, to the neighbor down the street who is constantly working to improve the community. What candidates should share is a strong sense of self, a success-driven work ethic and extraordinary accomplishments to show for it.

Each nomination must include:

Nominating process:

Please submit all pertinent information in the format requested to ensure that each nominee is considered equally.

Nominee information:

- At least 3 bullet points describing nominee's contribution to her profession.

Examples:

- Assisted with initiatives to raise awareness of various options available for training within a field.
- Created a new program designed to streamline service to clients within the organization.
- Helped produce a promotional video that can be shown to students interested in pursuing a career in certain fields.

- At least 3 bullet points describing nominee's contribution to her community.

Examples:

- Was instrumental in planning a yearly community yard sale to raise funds for scholarships to local students.
- Donates countless hours to a non-profit dedicated to help disabled students.
- Serves on the board of the City Citizen Emergency Preparedness Subcommittee.

- At least 3 bullet points describing nominee's leadership achievements.

Examples:

- Was selected by her organization as Employee of the Year for three years in a row.
- Led a year-long campaign to raise awareness of the services offered to Veterans in our community.
- Helped her daughters school create a new annual fundraiser.
