## **NAFTA PROGRESS IS PROMISING, TRILATERAL AGREEMENT REMAINS THE FINAL GOAL**

**SAN DIEGO (Aug. 27, 2018)** – The San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce issued the following statement from President and CEO Jerry Sanders today regarding the United States and Mexico reaching a preliminary agreement to revise NAFTA:

**“After a process of many starts and stops, it is promising news to see the U.S. and Mexico reach an agreement on NAFTA. While details have yet to be revealed and some issues remain outstanding, including sign-off from Canada, we are optimistic that this signals a continued path forward for trilateral trade.**

**“As a border region we are keenly aware of the role that trade plays in the growth and success of businesses that call San Diego home. Mexico is San Diego’s top export market. Trade agreements like NAFTA have helped to create a thriving binational economy, with a co-producing manufacturing supply chain that accounts for \$2.5 billion in trade between San Diego and Baja, California. After Mexico, Canada is the second largest consumer of San Diego’s goods and services. We are not just trading partners. We are producing together.**

**“Today marks a milestone in the modernization of NAFTA, but ultimately the U.S., Mexico, and Canada must come together to reach a trilateral agreement. The positive results we’ve seen from NAFTA in San Diego, in California, and across the nation are a result of our strength and competitiveness as a strong, unified North America.”**
