# RECAP: County of San Diego Update for the Business Community December 16, 2020

## **Funding Source Update:**

- The Small Business Stimulus Grant is open for applications.
  - For profit or nonprofit organizations headquartered in San Diego County with 100 or fewer employees. Must have a minimum of 1 year operating history, have experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19 and been impacted by the Regional Stay Home Order.
  - If you have already applied, you do not need to reapply. You can email your district contact to let them know you have previously applied and still have funding needs.

#### **General Announcements:**

- The County has released updated <u>holiday guidance</u>.
- Download CA Notify to add your phone to California's notification exposure system.

#### **Highlights**

- Guidance on reporting employees that tested positive for COVID-19.
  - Employers must notify the County of San Diego Public Health Services about an employee who tests positive with COVID-19, even in a remote workplace, by completing the online <u>COVID-19 Notification Form</u>.
- Retail operations under the Regional Stay Home Order.
  - Retail can stay open but is limited to 20% capacity, based on the fire department occupancy limit.
- Cal/OSHA, CDC, and State regulations.

- Governor Newsom signed an <u>executive order</u> on December 14, updating Cal/OSHA and CDC guidance on when an employee can return to work: after the end of an isolation or quarantine period recommended by CDPH, or a local health officer.
- CDPH released updated guidelines on December 14 outlining options to reduce quarantine periods during critical staffing shortages.
- Cal/OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards went into effect November 30. FAQs are available here.
- o CDC guidance is available here, and when to guarantine or isolate here.
- Vaccination distribution information.
  - <u>Vaccination distribution plans</u> are determined at the federal, state and local level. The CDC has only decided on Phase 1a, with a draft guidelines working group to further prioritize groups within categories (ex. Health care workers).
  - County advice: Be ready that employees and essential workers are informed and ready to go. The plan is being refined as we go.
