





RECAP: County of San Diego Update for the Business Community January 13, 2021

General Announcements:

- <u>Download CA Notify</u> to add your phone to California's notification exposure system.
- What communication resources for the COVID-19 vaccine would be helpful for your business? The <u>feedback form</u> will close on Friday January 15, 2021.

Highlights

- Johnson and Johnson's single dose vaccine may submit for emergency authorization by the end of this month, and AstraZeneca by the end of March.
- The Regional Stay at Home Order will be extended until the Southern California region reaches 15% ICU bed capacity.
- The California Department of Public Health released an <u>updated travel advisory</u> on January 6. The advisory recommends against travelling more than 120 miles from a place of residence. Anyone that has traveled to a different state or country is advised to self-quarantine for 10 days after arrival.
- An employer is required to <u>report to the County</u> if an employee tests positive for COVID, even if they live in a different county or Tijuana.
- The County is currently vaccinating healthcare workers and employees and residents of long term care facilities (Phase A, Tier 1-3). <u>California's Drafting Guidelines Workgroup</u> determines the more detailed Tiers within each vaccination phase. The California COVID-19 vaccination plan is available <u>here</u>.
- The County has more detailed information on the vaccination plan in San Diego. Learn more about when your sector is eligible to get vaccinated here.
 - O More detailed vaccine guidance for employers is expected in the coming weeks.
- Cal-OSHA updated FAQs on their Emergency Temporary Standards.

• Employees with young children could be sending them back to school in the coming months. Governor Newsom released his budget proposal last Friday, including \$2 billion to reopen schools. The plan would prioritize in person education for K-2, and consolidate school guidance into a single strategy.
