

RECAP: County of San Diego Update for the Business Community January 27, 2021

General Announcements

- Next Wednesday, February 3, the County will be hosting the Small Business
 Administration in a Special Business Sector Telebriefing from 9:30 10:30 am.

Highlights

- Sunday morning, the Regional Stay at Home order was rescinded. Find more information on safe reopening steps <u>here</u>. Restaurants, food and beverage providers have <u>specific</u> industry guidance.
- The updated County public health order, effective January 25, is available here.
- The following sectors are open with modifications under the Purple Tier of the state's Blueprint for a Safer Economy:
 - Restaurants: outdoor only from 5am 10pm. Take-out and delivery are open 24 hours. Live entertainment is permitted with social distancing, and further guidance on live entertainment is expected soon.
 - Wineries: outdoor only
 - O Bars, breweries, distilleries that serve food: operate as restaurant
 - O Personal care hair salons, barbershops, nail salons, tattoo parlors: open indoors
 - Grocery stores: 50% indoor
 - o Retail: 25% indoor
 - o Hotels: open
 - o Professional Sports: open without live audiences
 - o Offices: remote
 - o K-12 Schools: distance learning if not already open for in-person instruction
 - o Amusement Parks: closed

- Places of worship: outdoor only
- O Gyms: outdoor only
- o Family entertainment centers: outdoor only
- Youth and Rec Adult Sports: outdoor only with low contact
- Movie theaters, museums, zoos and aquariums: outdoor only
- Outdoor recreation: open
- Gatherings of up to three households allowed, as long as they are outdoors, at least six feet apart with face coverings.

• City of San Diego Temporary Outdoor Business Operation Permit

- Information on Temporary Outdoor Business Operation Permits can be found here.
- O The permit allows for temporary use of a street, sidewalk or parking lane for business in the City of San Diego.
 - If your operation is more than 400 ft and requires a tent, the fire marshal needs to be contacted to ensure state compliance.
 - Operations conducted within private properties, such as privately owned parking lots, are <u>not required</u> to obtain the Temporary Outdoor Business Operation Permit.
 - The new standard drawing to support the Temporary Outdoor Business Operation program is available here.

Vaccinations

- Updated vaccination information and vaccination locations can be found here.
- O MyTurn, piloted in San Diego and LA, has now been launched statewide. Register here to get notified when you're eligible to receive the vaccine.
- O Phase 1A and Phase 1B Tier 1, individuals over age 65, is vaccinating now. Phase 1B Tier 1 and 2 is vaccinating next. The County is waiting for state guidance to further prioritize categories within 1B - Tier 1 and 2.
- O Details on state designations on Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers can be found here.
- O When it's your turn to be vaccinated, documentation is required to prove employment in an eligible sector (ex. <u>photo ID</u>, <u>letter from employer</u>, <u>paystubs</u>). If you have recommendations on identification specific to your industry, email <u>COVID-Business@sdcounty.ca.gov</u>.
