AFFORDABLE HOUSING

According to the 2021 Affordable
Housing Needs Report for San Diego
County, 132,298 low-income renter
households in our region do not have
access to an affordable home.



HOMELESSNESS

The Regional Task Force on Homelessness reports that in the last reporting year, more than **21,000** persons experiencing homelessness accessed assistance in San Diego.



HEALTHCARE

In 2021, nearly **200,000** San Diegans were eligible for affordable healthcare assistance through Covered California.



AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Townspeople owns and operates four affordable housing developments in San Diego, with a total of 118 units.



RENTAL ASSISTANCE

With support from the U.S.
Department of Housing and
Urban Development, annually
we administer rental assistance
to hundreds of households.



SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

On and off-site supportive service offerings for our tenants include crisis intervention, care coordination, resource referrals, youth engagement, and case management.



EMERGENCY HOUSING

In collaboration with local motels, we operate year-round, non-congregate emergency housing for individuals living with HIV / AIDs who are experiencing homelessness.


