Measure B - People's Ordinance

This measure presents voters with the chance to reconsider how the City pays for its trash pick-up, and provide a more equitable way forward, without putting additional strain on City budgets as it provides this service to some San Diegans for free.

Measure C - Midway Height Limit

To ensure the redevelopment of the Midway area in our City reaches its full potential and provides the housing our workforce needs, it's necessary to raise the height limit in this specific, geographically limited, area that is not coastal and won't interfere with views.

Measure H - Access to Childcare

Childcare presents a significant hindrance for working families because the City is deficient in childcare supply. This will allow childcare to be offered at existing City facilities and can expand capacity quickly without unnecessary extra costs.

Prop 26 - Sports Betting at Tribal Casinos

Creates a system where in-person sports betting is allowed at racetracks and tribal casinos, without creating a gambling free for all. Prop 26 would generate significant funds for the state which would be dedicated primarily to schools, and then be placed in the general fund, all while supporting the economic driver of our local tribal casinos and their workforce.



OPPOSE

Prop 27 - Online Sports Betting

Proposition 27 would allow for broad legalization of online sports betting, and undercuts existing agreements the state has made with tribes that has allowed them sovereign rights to operate gaming locations.
