CHAMBER NAMES 2025 SMALL BUSINESS AWARD WINNERS

Five local small businesses were honored for their contributions to the San Diego region's economy and communities.

SAN DIEGO (July 10, 2025)— Tonight, the <u>San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce</u> honored five local, small businesses for their significant contributions to our communities and regional economy through the <u>Small Business Awards and Summer Celebration</u>.

Chamber member businesses with 50 or fewer employees were eligible to apply or be nominated for awards in four categories: Community All-Star, Customers First, Nonprofit Leader, and Outstanding Diversity-Owned Business. In addition, Chamber leadership and staff selected one member to receive a fifth award, Legacy Partner.

This year's winners are:

<u>Top Notch Finders, Inc.</u>—Winner of the **Community All-Star Award**, which
recognizes a small business that is dedicated to helping others and making a
positive impact in the community.







- San Diego Employers Association— Winner of the Customers First Award, which
 recognizes a small business that makes customer service its top priority and sets
 itself apart from the competition.
- <u>Doors of Change</u>— Winner of the **Nonprofit Leader Award**, which recognizes a
 nonprofit organization contributing to meaningful change and helping to make our
 region the best place to live and work.
- Black in Marine Science Winner of the Outstanding Diversity-Owned Business
 Award, which recognizes the success of a small business contributing to the
 growth and diversity of San Diego's economy.
- Business Office Outfitters was honored with the Legacy Partner Award, which
 recognizes a long-standing Chamber member small business that exemplifies
 outstanding engagement and partnership.

All award nominations (excluding Legacy Partner) were evaluated by a panel of Chamber members who reviewed applications and scored them based on how well they met the award category criteria. Winners were selected based on the highest score in each category.
