Chamber-Led Delegation to Address Regional Priorities in Sacramento

The two-day agenda includes meetings covering a variety of issues, such as housing, energy, healthcare, and trade.

SAN DIEGO (February 2, 2026) – This week, business and civic leaders from the San Diego region will travel to the state capital to advocate for legislation that benefits businesses and helps advance regional priorities during the San Diego Regional Chamber’s Annual Leadership Delegation to Sacramento, happening February 3-4.

Nearly 90 delegates will join the two-day trip to the state capital. Advocates will meet with over a dozen policymakers to ensure the San Diego region’s business community’s voice is considered as they craft legislation in the new session, which began earlier this month.

“As Sacramento sets the course for California’s future this legislative session, San Diego’s business community is ensuring it will not be on the sidelines,” said **Chris Cate, San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce President and CEO**. “Our annual Sacramento delegation trip puts the voice of our region’s business community directly in front of the leaders making the most consequential decisions on jobs, housing, energy, and trade. When we show up in force and engage face-to-face, we make sure San Diego’s economic priorities are not just heard but acted on.”
